Our local area is seeing movement toward the easing of stay at home orders with the most restrictions. The Philadelphia area could move to the yellow phase (Safer at Home) as of Friday, June 5, 2020. In New Jersey, as of June 15, 2020, retail stores will reopen with a reduced capacity as well as outdoor dining. On June 22, 2020, salons and barbershops will be able to reopen, also at reduced capacity. Please continue to monitor state resources for the most up to date information.

NEW JERSEY CHILD CARE CENTERS REOPENING JUNE 15, 2020

Following Governor Murphy's signing today of Executive Order No. 149, which will reopen childcare centers in the State of New Jersey beginning June 15, the New Jersey Department of Children and Families today released specific operating guidance for centers in order to preserve the health and safety of children, staff and the families being served. - Centers will be required to screen children and staff each day, prior to entry into the center.
- Class and group sizes will be limited, and groups must be spaced out throughout the
- center.
- Staff will be required to wear cloth masks, and children over the age of 2 will be
- encouraged, whenever feasible, to wear masks.
- Childcare centers will be required to engage in enhanced cleaning and sanitation.
